Event Details for vendors/demonstrators: Set up for vendors & demonstrators will begin promptly at 7:30am on Saturday April 21. All vending must be set up and ready to go no later than 9am.

No motorized vehicles will be allowed in base camp from 9am-4:30pm. All applicants falling under the category of "educational demonstrators" agree to spend a minimum of 2 scheduled hours conducting interactive demonstrations of a craft or skill & donation of a raffle item of a \$25 value. Arrangements can be made in advance for early set-up on Friday - just call or email to let us know when to expect you. We ask that no one begin taking down their vending areas until 4pm on the day of the event. A vending space includes a maximum of 4 event passes. If you plan on having more than 4 people operating your vending space - each additional person must pay for festival admittance. Turtle Island Preserve reserves the right to deny vending space to anyone who poses a threat to public safety or health, or for any other reason. Neither Turtle Island Preserve nor its affiliates will be liable/responsible for loss, damage, theft, or personal & property injury during this event. Participants must comply with all local, state, and federal tax/licensing, safety regulations, and health codes.
